

Dear Families,

The elementary schools in the Snoqualmie Valley School District use a standards-based reporting system. The term standards-based refers to instruction, assessment, grading, and academic reporting based on students demonstrating understanding or mastery of the Washington State Standards.

As we inform instructional practice and accurately articulate student progress towards grade level standards, you will notice adjustments to graded work and assessments, including end-of-trimester report cards.

The update in the report card effectively reflects your child's progress towards demonstrating understanding of grade level standards by the end of the academic year. As referenced in the chart below, the first and second trimesters will reflect progress toward end-of-year standards. Third trimester, your child will earn a standards-based grade reflecting the level of mastery of end-of-year standards.
